Shooting

Four archers per boss in two details of two. Arrows will be shot in ends of three in two minutes. Recurve and compound archers will shoot on vertical 60 cm three spot faces. Longbow and Barebow archers will shoot on single 60cm faces. Juniors may shoot a three spot but must indicate so on the entry form, they will still be in the same competition as archers shooting a single spot face.

Lincolnshire Champion trophies will be awarded from amongst the Lincs archers only. Medals will be awarded for placing regardless of Lincs affiliation.

The main trophies will be available for photographs but will stay in the possession of the Lincolnshire Tournament Organiser thereafter

Photographs will be taken on the day for use on the L.C.A.S. Website. If you have any objections to your photograph being used please let the tournament organiser know on your entry form

When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth/Age category, Email, Address, Phone Number, Club (and ID) Round (unless defined by Age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability Info
